Sober and elegant, this two-body bookcase in blond birch embodies the spirit of the Louis-Philippe style, revisited in the XX^e century with meticulous, functional craftsmanship.

The upper body opens with three glass doors with molded frames forming an arch, revealing a four-level interior that can be modulated thanks to shelves mounted on racks, adjustable in height as required. This compartment provides ample display space for books, objets d'art or collections.

The lower, deeper body features three full doors with framed panels, providing ample, discreet storage space. The whole unit rests on a solid plinth, typical of the Louis-Philippe style, combining sober lines and the warmth of wood.

All locks are functional and come with their own keys. A piece of furniture with character, both practical and decorative, ideal for structuring a work, reading or reception area with distinction.
